## AI Detection Policy for the IB Program

As a rule, students will not use AI, but this is subject to teacher discretion.

When a teacher allows AI use, the following policy will apply.

The source must be cited.

AI may be used no more than once in a paper.

AI will be treated as a tertiary source, not as a primary or secondary source.

If detected, the student will be instructed to choose a new topic.

Any time AI is used to substantiate a summary, to paraphrase, or to quote information, it must be cited.

No more than 50 words in a row without citations will be considered plagiarism.

Consequences for infractions may include the following.

For a rough draft, the teacher will discuss the infraction and the student will be cautioned.

For a final draft, the student will receive a zero. Teachers will not submit any final draft that demonstrates 10% or more than 50 consecutive words that have not been cited in a paper.
