School and Community

Winter Springs High School, a comprehensive 9th through 12th grade secondary school, is located in the city of Winter Springs, Florida, whose population is 37,294. The school opened its doors in 1997 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2000. Winter Springs High School graduated the first class of International Baccalaureate Diploma Candidates in 2021. The academic program is organized on a hybrid schedule of 7 periods a day, 3 days a week and a block schedule 2 days a week. Students can earn 7 credits in an academic year. The current enrollment at Winter Springs High School is 1,963. The student body is culturally diverse with a population that is 32% Hispanic, 10% African American, 5% Asian and 49% White. 53% of our students receive free or reduced lunch.

Faculty

Over 55% of the faculty/staff hold advanced degrees, five with doctorate degrees. Our full-time teachers and administrators have an average of more than 15 years of experience.

Profile of Graduates

Winter Springs High School offers a rigorous and challenging curriculum that prepares students to attend the finest colleges and universities in America with at 94% graduation rate. Approximately 85% of the graduating class of 2021 participated in post-secondary education with 25% enrolling in state colleges and 60% planning to attend four-year colleges or universities. The graduating class of 2021 earned more than 5.2 million scholarship dollars and included three National Merit Finalist Award Winners.

WSHS students have been accepted at prestigious colleges and universities. Among them are the following: University of Pennsylvania, Yale University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Duke University, Carnegie Mellon University, New York University, University of Maryland, John Hopkins University, University of Florida, Florida State University, Virginia Tech, California Polytechnic University, Holy Cross, Stetson University, University of Miami, University of Kentucky, Rutgers University, Vanderbilt University, Georgia Tech, Brigham Young University, University of Mississippi, and University of Central Florida.

Technology

Winter Springs High School makes extensive use of state-of-the art technology. In addition to its 150 computer stations in the Media Center, there are numerous mobile laptop labs and classroom computer labs. Teachers regularly utilize the latest instructional technology tools and post course content through Canvas, resulting in a blended learning model to combine direct instruction with online learning. Science teachers fully integrate the use of digital probeware to collect and analyze data for lab experiments. World Language teachers utilize four state-of-the-art language labs. Winter Springs employs a full-time technology facilitator and a network specialist to provide hardware and software assistance to all teachers and staff.

Student Sports and Activities

Winter Springs High School offers a rich and varied athletic program, with opportunities in 35 different sports teams. Our extra-curricular clubs and activities include drama, chorus, band, journalism, art and world language organizations. Student Government is another vehicle for leadership and involvement. Finally, WSHS is proud to offer a number of honor societies and service organizations, including the National Honor Society, Beta Club, Rho Kappa, English Honor Society, Key Club, our nationally recognized Army JROTC and the Hunnybears dance team, among many others.
